

Delta State Public Procurement Commission Law, 2016

PART I - ESTABLISHMENT OF THE DELTA STATE COUNCIL ON PUBLIC PROCUREMENT

3. (1) There is hereby established for the Commission the State Council on Public Procurement (in this Law referred to as "Council").

(2) The Council shall:

- a) consider, approve and amend the monetary threshold and the prior review thresholds for the application of the provisions of this Law by the procuring entity;
- b) consider and approve policies on public procurement;
- c) consider the Appointment of the Directors of the Commission;
- d) receive and consider, for approval, the audited accounts of the Commission;
- e) approve changes in the procurement process to adapt to improvements in modern technology;
- f) give; such other directive and perform such other functions as may be necessary to achieve the objectives of this Law.
